Customer Direct Debit Request (DDR) Service Agreement: This document outlines our service commitment to you, in respect of the Direct Debit Request (DDR) arrangements made between Oasis Africa Australia and you.

Our commitment to you: Initial terms of the arrangement: In terms of the Direct Debit Request arrangements made between us and signed by you, we undertake to periodically debit your nominated account for the agreed amount.

Drawing arrangements: The first drawing under this Direct Debit arrangement will occur on the date nominated on the Direct Debit Request. If any drawing falls due on a non-business day, it will be debited to your account on the next business day following the scheduled drawing date. We will give you at least 14 days notice in writing, by email or by phone when changes to the initial terms of the arrangement are made. This notice will state the new amount, frequency, next drawing date and any other changes to the initial terms. If you wish to discuss any changes to the initial terms, please contact us.

Your rights: Changes to the arrangement: If you want to make changes to the drawing arrangements, contact us. These changes may include: deferring the drawing; or altering the schedule; or stopping an individual debit; or suspending the DDR; or canceling the DDR completely.

Confidentiality: All personal customer information held by us will be kept confidential except that information provided to our financial institution to initiate the drawing to your nominated account.

Your commitment to us: It is your responsibility to ensure that: your nominated account can accept direct debits (your financial institution can confirm this); and that on the drawing date there are sufficient cleared funds in the nominated account; and that you advise us if the nominated account is transferred or closed.

If your credit card expiry date is due to be renewed: If your drawing is returned or dishonoured by your financial institution, we may re-draw on your account after four (4) business days, or contact you to arrange alternate payment. Any transaction fees payable by us in respect of the above may be added to your account.

If funds raised exceed the requirement for this project, the funds may be directed to a similar project.
