'Let us run with perseverance the race marked out for us, fixing our eyes on Jesus, the pioneer and perfecter of faith' Hebrews 12:2–3 This week marks one year since it was announced we had accepted the call to serve the gospel in Gladstone. A lot has happened this year. Sunday services have been a source of encouragement and joy. Our preaching series has explored several biblical books and themes, including Luke's Gospel, salvation from Eden to Eternity, HOPE25, Daniel, and Hebrews. Our church family have responded well to seriesstyle preaching, supplemented by Bible study books for group or individual Bible studies.

Sunday attendance has steadily grown over the year – a source of real encouragement. We are getting used to having new people at church most weeks. At St Peter's, Kids' Church recommenced in January and one Sunday we had 11 kids!

Give God great thanks for our community of faithful

Outreach is a core part of our mission to know Christ and make Him known. This happens in many ways, but particularly through our Op Shop, Soup Kitchen, Shed Sale and RI. In September, we hosted the National Police Remembrance Day service, honouring those who lost their lives in the line of duty.

Every day, we have opportunities to serve our local community, pray for them and encourage them. Some of these conversations have borne good fruit including a parent and three kids coming to church.

Other conversations can take a lot of energy, wisdom and grace – caring for people struggling with homelessness, addiction and health issues. These ministries wouldn't happen without the faithful service of many volunteers.

Give thanks for the privilege of serving the community as an example of Jesus, tending to people's physical and spiritual needs. Give thanks for the volunteers and donors who make these outreach ministries possible. Pray for building strong relationships and wisdom in pastoral care.

Christmas planning is well under way. Life in Central Queensland has a different rhythm to the Darling Downs, but the birth of Jesus is at the heart of why we are here. We are currently discerning how to best use our time and energy for Christmas services.

Planning for preaching and Bible studies is well underway, with a chance to dig deep into a series on prayer, our baptismal vows, Matthew's Gospel, Genesis and Romans. We're also looking forward to joining in at CMS Summer School in

January, BCA Connect in April, as well as the BCA Field Staff Conference in July.

Give thanks for the privilege of planning for next year. Pray for the Holy Spirit to lead all decisions in ministry. Give thanks for the opportunity to gather with fellow ministry workers and be encouraged through teaching and fellowship. Pray that more people would be willing to 'go the distance' in supporting BCA's mission.

In August, we headed off for a family wedding and much needed R&R. Travelling to Türkiye was an incredible
