This opportunity is open to a Bible college graduate for a full-time, two-year assistant minister/training role at the Bathurst Cathedral.

In this role, the candidate will receive training in both traditional and contemporary Anglican services.

You will contribute to the life of the Cathedral's congregations through preaching, leading Bible studies, evangelism and pastoral care and experience funeral, baptism and wedding ministry.

Training will also be provided in administrative and church function skills.

Why Bathurst?

Bathurst is a vibrant regional city in the Central Tablelands of New South Wales, about 200 km west of Sydney. Known as Australia's oldest inland settlement, it played a key role in the gold rush of the 1850s and still showcases grand colonial architecture and heritage sites. It's famously home to Mount Panorama, one of the world's most iconic racing circuits.

It features excellent healthcare, including Bathurst Base Hospital—currently undergoing a \$200 million redevelopment to expand services and facilities. The city is also a hub for education, with a wide choice of public, private, and independent schools, plus tertiary institutions like Charles Sturt University and TAFE.

Bathurst blends historic charm with modern infrastructure, has affordable housing, short commutes, and a strong sense of community. It has a population of just over 37,000 people.
