



# WEST WYALONG DIOCESE OF BATHURST

**Bush Church Aid, in partnership with the Anglican Diocese of Bathurst, seek an ordained Anglican minister for the position of Minister in Charge in West Wyalong.**

West Wyalong is a historic rural town in central New South Wales. Once a booming gold rush settlement in the 1890s, it has since become an agricultural hub, especially known for its wheat and cereal crops.

West Wyalong has a population of around 3000 people according to the 2021 Census.

West Wyalong is the main town of the Bland Shire in the Central West of NSW. It has 3 primary schools and 1 high-school. There is a TAFE college in the community.

West Wyalong has a district hospital and also is served by GPs, 2 dental surgeries and 2 pharmacies.

## Why West Wyalong Anglican?

St Barnabas Church is a generous and welcoming congregation who views worship at the centre of life. They meet for Holy Communion service each Sunday and on Tuesdays for an informal communion service. Other ministries include a Sunday School program, a regular Bible study group and aged care and hospital visitation. Average attendance on Sunday ranges between 35-45 people.

The ideal person will be someone with a missional heart and who will continue to build on current practices while encouraging younger families to join the congregation.

The facilities include the main church which seats over 200, a parish hall and a 4-bedroom parish rectory.

This ministry has been vacant since July 2024 and is currently cared for by locum ministers.
