February

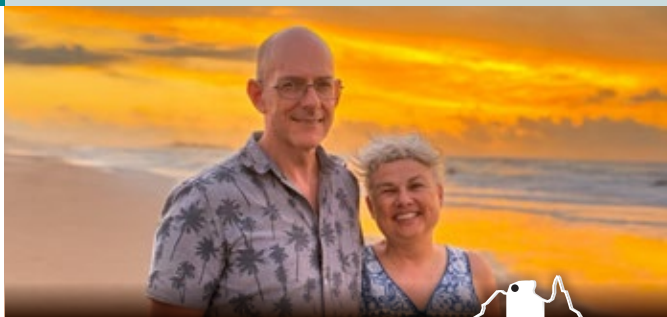
