## Thank God for the growth of the Gospel

*We always thank God, the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, when we pray for you, because we have heard of your faith in Christ Jesus and of the love you have for all God's people – the faith and love that spring from the hope stored up for you in heaven... Colossians 1:3–4*

At least forty times, Paul effuses joyful thankfulness to God in his letters! Thirty-nine times he's thankful to God for giving people saving faith in Jesus and their subsequent love for Jesus

and his people because of the Gospel preached to them!

It seems Epaphras and Philemon had learnt the Gospel from the Apostle Paul in Ephesus and then taken it 200 kms back to the region of Colossae that resulted in a new church plant meeting in Philemon's house.



Having heard of their faith in Christ from Epaphras (1:4, 8, 9) the Apostle Paul writes to them from prison in Rome. He thanks and praises God for them as another example of how the Gospel is bearing fruit and growing throughout the whole world. How is this happening?

As ordinary Epaphras-like women and men are willing to count the cost to take, tell and teach the Gospel to others!
