## Wickham Maintenance Team

### Risk Assessment

- Always keep the rake face down when placing it on the floor to stop people from accidentally stepping on it and making it hit them in their face
- Don't sniff paint fumes or the methylated spirits
- Work in pairs when on the ladders as it is safer as each person can look out for one another
- Wear closed in shoes and gloves when working
- Learn to use the equipment before taking using it in the field.
- Check shoes for spiders
- Be cautious for snakes
- Be careful around sharp items
- Wear sunscreen to prevent sunburn
