## Code of Conduct

### 1. Background

- i. Student delegates will be on site at Queensland Conference and Camping Centre for the duration of the conference, with the exception of planned and supervised activities held off-site, students will not have the opportunity to leave the site.
- ii. The student residential accommodation at Queensland Conference and Camping Centre has 24-hour security. All dorms have lockable doors, which will be locked each night. Adults (conference leaders and facilitators) will be accommodated in dorm rooms at the end of the student's dorms.
- iii. GRIP is committed to providing a fulfilling and challenging experience for the student delegates attending GNSL 2017. It expects that delegates will demonstrate a high standard of behaviour and conduct themselves in a manner consistent with the values and expectations of their respective schools.
- iv. All student delegates must accept at registration their shared responsibility for maintaining a safe, respectful and harmonious conference environment.

### 2. Agreement

By submitting a Final Registration Form, delegates agree to the following:

- To attend all conference sessions and activities
- Not to leave the conference venue, or a program session without permission
- Not to leave Queensland Conference and Camping Centre after conference activities have concluded in the evenings
- Only to use the pool at planned and supervised times
- Not to bring onto the site or use cigarettes, alcohol or prohibited substances
- Ensure their actions or inactions do not harm or bring into disrepute GRIP or their school's reputation or good standing



# GRIP LEADERSHIP

- Treat all staff, other delegates, QCCC staff and visitors with courtesy, respect and tolerance
- Not behave in a way that disrupts or interferes with any conference activity, teaching or learning
- Be sensitive and respectful to the needs of QCCC staff and visitors
- Not engage in behaviour that is detrimental to Queensland Conference and Camping Centre property
- Comply with reasonable direction or request from QCCC or GRIP Staff and representatives
- Not engage in unlawful behaviour
