QLD Government Statement of Compliance:

From 1am Thursday 14 April 2022, the Public Health and Social Measures linked to vaccination status Direction was revoked, removing the requirement for the COVID Safe Checklist.

NSW Government Statement of Compliance:

Updated 23 July 2022: Anyone can visit an entertainment facility or indoor and outdoor recreation facilities.

- Visitors and staff are not required to be fully vaccinated or carry vaccination evidence.
- COVID-19 Safe Check-in is not required.
- Face masks are not required.

Businesses are no longer required to have a Safety Plan.

GRIP Leadership Duty of Care
