## Covid-Safe Considerations for GRIP Student Leadership Conference

This policy will be updated in accordance with any current health directives that exist at the time of a conference.

### **QLD Government Statement of Compliance:**

From 1am Thursday 14 April 2022, the Public Health and Social Measures linked to vaccination status Direction was revoked, removing the requirement for the COVID Safe Checklist.

### **NSW Government Statement of Compliance:**

Updated 23 July 2022: Anyone can visit an entertainment facility or indoor and outdoor recreation facilities.

- Visitors and staff are not required to be fully vaccinated or carry vaccination evidence.
- COVID-19 Safe Check-in is not required.
- Face masks are not required.

Businesses are no longer required to have a Safety Plan.

### **GRIP Leadership Duty of Care**

GRIP Leadership takes very seriously it's duty of care to all attendees. In providing an all-round safe environment, careful consideration will be given to ensure a Covid-Safe environment. Such provisions include:

**VENUES:** Utilising commercial event venues that are already approved fit-for-service for large groups, and are subject to all government building regulations and health and safety requirements.

**HYGIENE:** Ensuring the availability of hand washing facilities, and regular cleaning of venues.

**PROGRAM:** Creating suitable breaks in the conference program for fresh air, similar to that of a normal school day.

**COMMUNICATION:** Maintaining an accurate record of attending groups and their group contact, should follow-up communication be necessary for health purposes.
