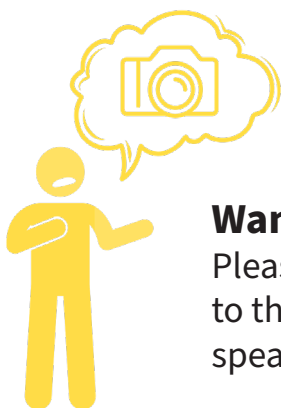
HELP DESK

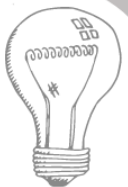

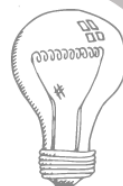

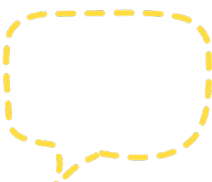












DISCUSSION: Once you have listed the five qualities, have a discussion with other people to share your answers with each other.

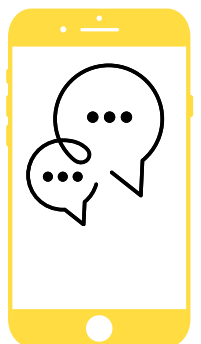

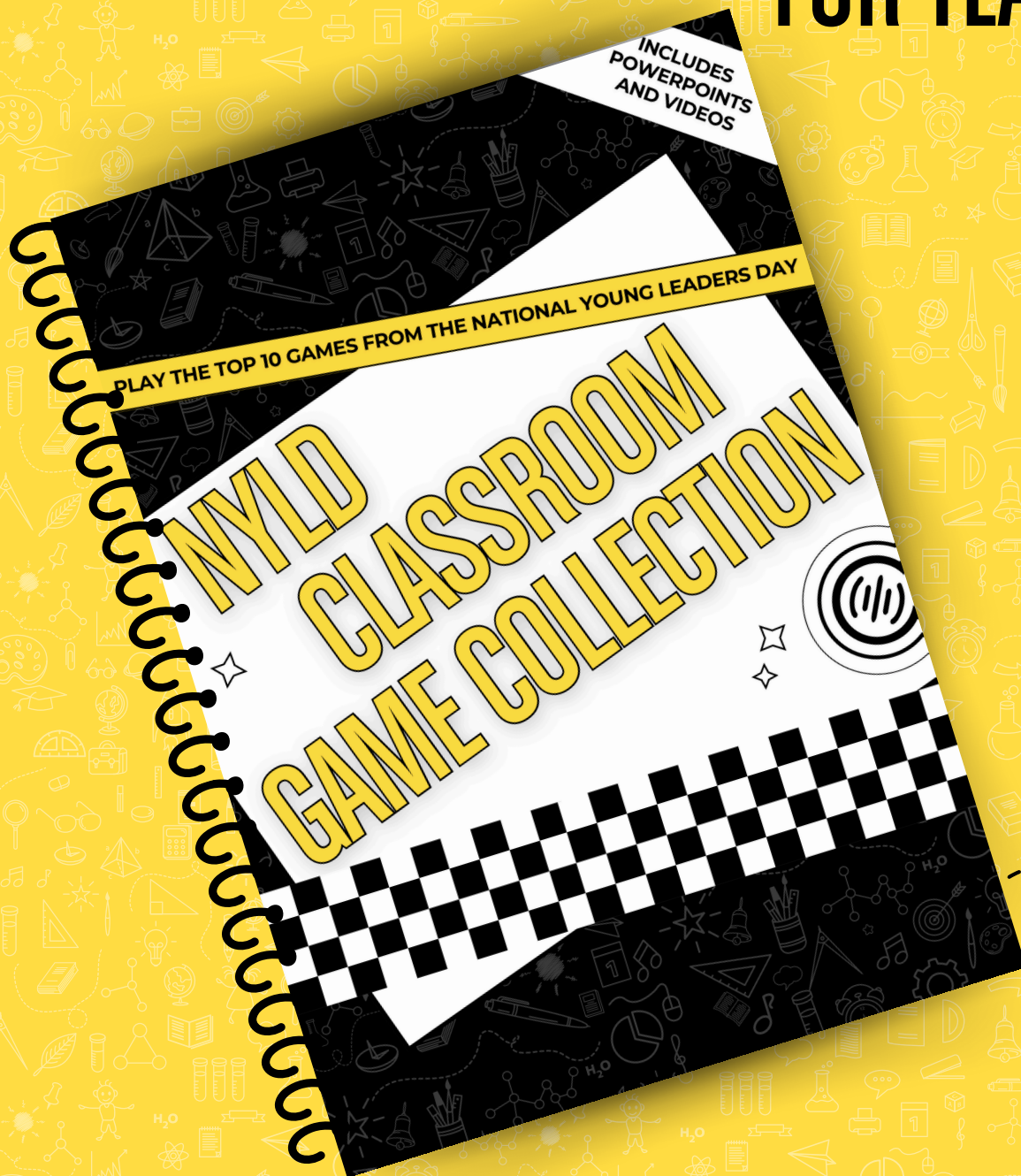
